## Key responsibilities:

- Conducting clinical assessments and formulating treatment plans and case formulations
- Providing psychotherapeutic treatment to clients in both individual and group settings
- Conducting workshops and coaching session for individuals and teams
- Ensure continuity of care through documentation, reporting and interprofessional coordination
- Utilising rTMS (Repetitive Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation) as part of the treatment process (training provided if needed)
- Monitor and evaluate client progress according to the treatment plan, and coordinate with team members to achieve treatment goals
- Work closely with recovery counsellors, other therapists, medical team, and external service providers in a collaborative approach to treatment
- Accurately record necessary information in the electronic medical records (EMR) system and ensure compliance with policies and procedures
- Actively contributing to the formulation, implementation, and ongoing development of NEOVIVA's therapeutic programme, with space for clinical reflection, initiative, and evidence-informed innovation.
